

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND FANS GETTING ON POST

The **Fort Riley Visitor Control Center** (Bldg. 885) is located just prior to the Henry Gate Access Control Point (Exit 301, U.S. Interstate Highway 70) and is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Anyone without a Visitors Pass or Acceptable identification must complete an application for access to Fort Riley. A criminal background check is part of the application process.

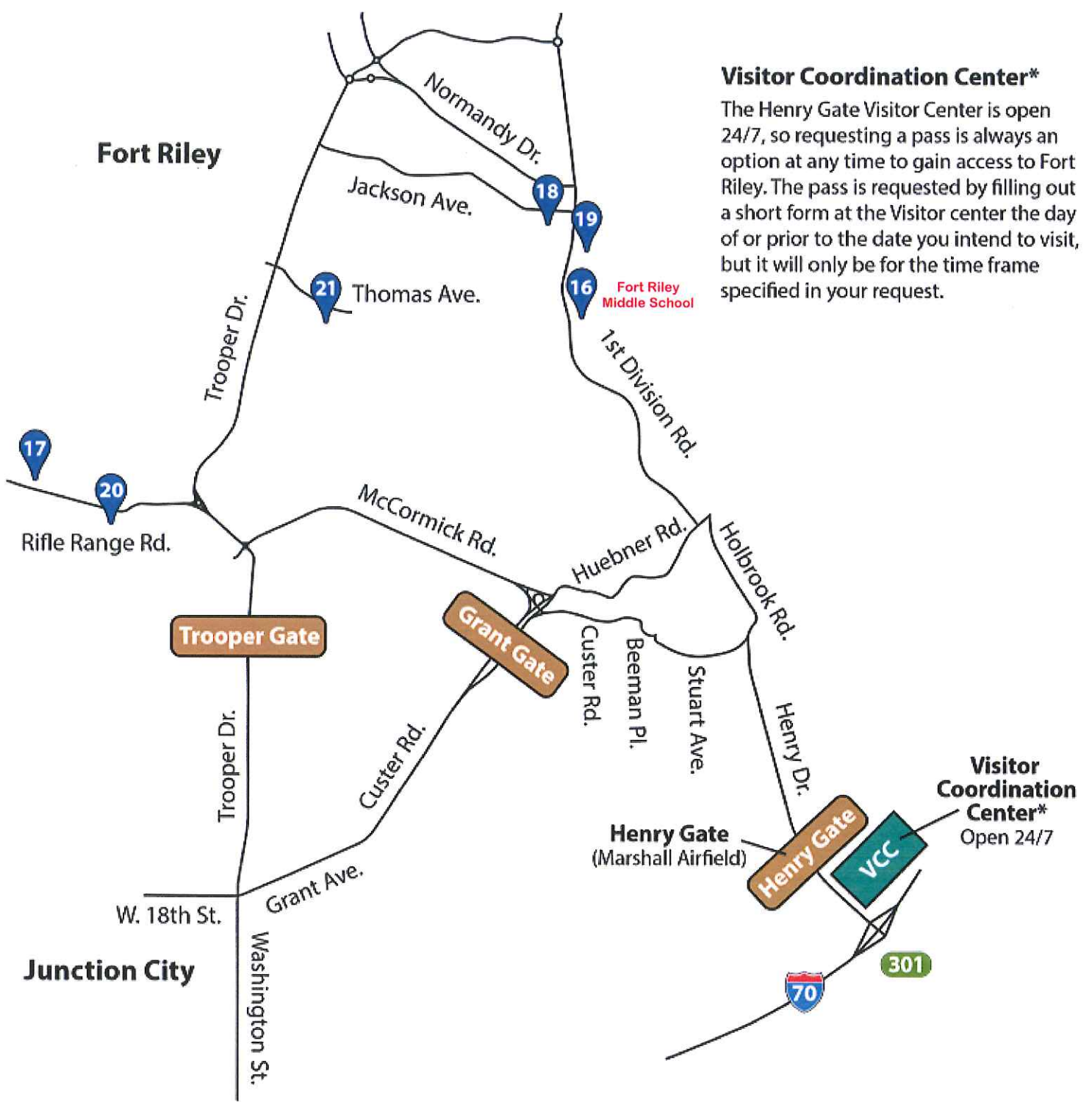
SPECTATORS: Must complete a Visitor Pass Application and submit an application via email or in person to the Fort Riley Visitor Control Center to obtain a pass to attend the event

- Then make a left on Huebner Rd.
- Turn right on 1st Division Rd.
- FRMS will be on the right, drive past the first entryway to the main entrance.
