The board reserves the right to establish the specifications for and quality of goods or services purchased by the district.

Specifications

It is the responsibility of the originator of a purchase request to see that all specifications requested are complete.

Standardization

Whenever possible, standard lists of supplies and equipment shall be developed in all budget areas.

Quantity Purchasing

Quantity purchasing is encouraged.

Cost Control

The board reserves the right to maintain cost control authority over any goods or services.

DJEB-R Quality Control

DJEB-R

To achieve quality and competitive pricing based upon quantity purchase, the Superintendent shall require the following in directing purchases:

Specifications shall be written in a manner that will minimize vendor misinterpretation and shall be established for goods and services to be purchased.

DJEB-R Quality Control

DJEB-2

Specifications shall be sufficiently broad to permit competition while still retaining sufficient specificity to secure the desired level of quality. When possible the specifications shall cite commercially available "standard brands" as examples that meet the specifications.

Invitations to bid or supply quotations, with the exception of computer equipment purchased off state contract in accordance with KSA 72-6760(b)(8)*, on the specified products should be forwarded to all known vendors and suppliers within the local area and to others outside the area as requested.

* Computer equipment listed on state contract may be considered for purchase by the Board of Education after price quotes are solicited from state contract approved vendors.
